General

Contestants may compete individually or as a team.

The winning projects will be awarded monetary prizes and certificates. On top of that, all contestants will receive a certificate marking their valuable participation.

Judging Criteria

Project Abstract

- All participating teams must submit a four page write-up (softcopy) of their project to Esther Ling at ieee.curtinsarawak@gmail.com by 1 June 2013. Adhering to standard [IEEE A4 conference paper template](#).
- A 10% of the overall score will be allocated for the above judging criteria.

Project Impact

- A 50% of the general score will be allocated for clear underlined problem statement and for standard of addressing the problem stated.

Overall Presentation

- The overall presentation of the project must be creative. Moreover, the booth/project setup must be easy to understand. For the above task the team or individual contestant will be rewarded a score of 15%.

Visitor friendly

- A mark of 15% will be awarded based on the team members' presentation.

Evidence of research/data

- A sufficient amount data should be given to support the project/problem statement. Furthermore, there should also be adequate evidence to support the given data. 10% marks will be allocated.

Booth Setup

The following items will be given for each booth

- One table
- One power socket per booth
(For additional power points, participants are advised to bring their own extensions.)
- Two chairs
- Notice Board (upon request)
- Banner Holders (upon request)

Each project will be supported with an exhibition goodie-bag to assist in the booth set-up preparation. It will contain basic stationery items such as pens, pencils, and marker pens. However, participants are advised to be prepared with their individual project requirements.
